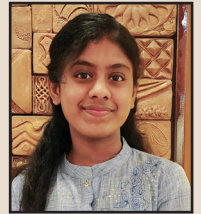




Faithful and Fearless The Women Who Shaped Deliverance



When we think of the Exodus, we usually think of Moses—God’s chosen leader who stood before Pharaoh and led the Israelites out of slavery. But if we look closely at the early chapters of Exodus, we find five remarkable women whose quiet courage and unwavering faith laid the groundwork for that great deliverance. Though they lived far from power, their bold choices helped preserve life when death was all around.

1. Jochebed, the Courageous Mother

In the face of Pharaoh’s cruel decree to kill every Hebrew baby boy, Jochebed made a heart-wrenching decision. She hid her son as long as she could, then placed him in a basket and set him afloat on the Nile—not out of fear, but out of faith. She trusted that the God who gave her this child would watch over him. (Exodus 2:1–3)

2. Miriam, the Watchful Sister

Miriam followed the basket. She stood at a distance, waiting and watching. And when Pharaoh’s daughter found the baby, Miriam stepped in with wisdom and courage beyond her years. Because of her, Moses was nursed by his own mother and raised with the love of his family. (Exodus 2:4, 7–8)

3. Pharaoh’s Daughter, the Bold Heart

She was raised in a palace of power, yet she listened to compassion instead of command. When she saw the baby crying, she didn’t turn away. She drew him from

the water and named him Moses. In that moment, she defied an empire with a single act of mercy. (Exodus 2:5-10)

4 & 5. Shiphrah and Puah, the Fearless Midwives

Before Moses was born, these two Hebrew midwives had already taken a stand. Ordered to kill newborn boys, they refused. Their reverence for God was greater than their fear of Pharaoh. Because of them, many Hebrew boys were saved—and one of them would go on to lead a nation to freedom. (Exodus 1:15-21)

These five women—some remembered by name, others barely mentioned—stood outside the spotlight, yet their choices shaped the very heart of God’s plan. While Pharaoh tried to crush a people through fear, they fought back with faith. While the empire chose death, they chose life.

The story of Exodus doesn’t begin with a man holding a staff. It begins with women holding on to hope.

When we feel unseen or unheard, may we remember them. God’s work often begins in hidden places, through faithful hearts and fearless obedience. The same God who moved through them is still moving through us today.
